

SCORES OF ALL CHILDREN AND YOUNG PERSONS WITH POST TRAUMATIC STRESS DISORDER TREATED BY FRANCESCA SIMMS WITH CHILDREN'S ACCELERATED TRAUMA THERAPY , (CATT)

PTSD scores as measured by CRIES 8 before and after one core therapy session using CATT to transfer the traumatic memory from the Amygdala to the Hippocampus so the PTSD reaction goes and the memory becomes available for logical thought.

(A score over 17 indicates PTSD with 87% reliability. The maximum possible score is 40)

Symptoms as measured by Post Traumatic Stress Disorder check list also disappeared after the CATT treatment and generally other difficulties such as depression, panic attacks, inability to leave the house, or attend school, also corrected themselves following the CATT treatment
